



Application Process

Thank you for considering studying at Assiniboine College. To help prevent delays in your application, please fill out the attached application and waiver form, it's important that the information is printed clearly.

Important information on the application form: Name, Social Insurance Number (SIN), Address, Date of birth (format is indicated on the application form) and Email address. *Please sign and date the second page* of the application form.

If someone is covering the cost of your course/program, leave the payment section blank. You are not charged an application fee.

If you have attended Assiniboine College, a student number would be ideal. However, we understand it's something that can often be forgotten.

For any previous Education (high school and post-secondary), an official transcript must be submitted to Assiniboine College. Official transcripts can be obtained by contacting your Educational Institution or a transcript request can be made to Manitoba Student Records at <https://www.edu.gov.mb.ca/k12/studrec/>

You can submit your official transcript by the following ways:

1. Mailed to Assiniboine College: Attention Admissions - 1430 Victoria Ave E, Brandon, MB R7A 2A9
2. The School/Institution can directly email to Assiniboine College admissions admissions@assiniboine.net
3. Dropped off at the Assiniboine College at the admissions department

Important Notice: Unofficial transcripts will not be accepted. Transcripts must be submitted using one of the three methods listed above to be considered valid.

Application Deadline:

April 27, 2026. All required documents must be submitted by this deadline. Late applications may not be considered.

Next Steps After Submission:

Once your application and all required documents are received:

1. Your application will be reviewed, and if necessary, additional documents may be requested.
2. If your application is successful, you will receive an acceptance letter and further instructions through email on student account access, course schedule, and orientation.
