We are seeking two permanent Operating/Mechanical Technician Trainees to join our Transmission Operations & Maintenance Department in Gillam, Manitoba.

Responsibilities:

- Participate actively in the development of the team and the achievement of the team's goals.
- Perform all necessary operations of station transmission and auxiliary equipment under normal and emergency conditions.
- Prepare detailed switching and operating procedures.
- Perform or direct all operations to isolate and restore equipment for maintenance.
- Perform installation, inspection and commissioning, and mechanical maintenance of breakers, transformers, refrigeration, air conditioning, heating systems, HVDC equipment, and associated equipment such as compressors, cranes, pumps, motors, fans etc. and understand its association with pneumatic and electronic controls.
- Responsible for troubleshooting station faults and carrying out repairs under emergency conditions.
- Provide direction and training to staff assigned to team.
- Compile plant maintenance records, maintain accurate and neat statistics, and have a demonstrated ability to prepare reports.
- Comply fully with safety procedures and regulations as well as enterprise, legislative, and regulatory requirements.

Qualifications:

- High school graduate with a minimum of the following courses: Mathematics 40S (Applied or Pre-Calculus); Physics 40S; and English 40.
OR
- Industrial Mechanic (millwright) Licence issued by the Province of Manitoba (or equivalent Provincial certification) and Grade 12 or equivalent, with the willingness to take part in, and successfully complete, Applied or Pre-calculus Math 40S and Physics 40S within a specified amount of time, if required.
- In addition, this Training Program requires you to:
 - Possess a valid Province of Manitoba Class 5 Driver's Licence (intermediate or full).
 - Obtain full certification as a Station Operator.
 - Maintain a level of physical fitness and mental alertness appropriate for the duties you are performing.
 - Have good physical coordination, manual dexterity, and be able to lift heavy objects from a variety of physical positions while working at heights requiring a bucket truck or ladder and while working in confined spaces.
 - Be capable of communicating effectively orally and in writing.
 - Have good hearing and accurate colour perception.
 - Have basic computer skills.
 - Have a mechanical aptitude to satisfy all requirements of the position.
 - Be willing to acquire an approved set of personal hand tools.
 - Be willing to attain the educational requirements.
 - Be willing to relocate to various locations within Manitoba, including Gillam.
