335 Main is a historic building transformation for the Red River Métis Nation. The project is now in the tenant improvement and interior fit-ups phase, and final works will include museum exhibit installations and exterior finishes including an art installation and main entry ramp.

The Superintendent or Assistant Superintendent for 335 Main will be working on a team with a lead Superintendent. Once the project is complete, the role may involve working on other projects, or on another team with a lead Superintendent. Superintendents oversee the onsite construction process and is responsible for and limited to construction daily activities assigned to established intended design. This can include planning and scheduling, organizing, directing and controlling activities of the allocated crew.



This includes, but is not limited to:

- Champion and provide leadership that promotes a safe work culture.
- Organize, direct and control activities on the job site.
- Maintaining the Bockstael Brand with all clients, employees, trade partners and supply chain partners.
- Manage schedules and assess workforce needs.
- Work closely with the site manager, project manager, owner, consultant, trade contractors, inspectors, regulatory agencies and other stakeholders to identify, develop, implement and support cost-effective project delivery.
